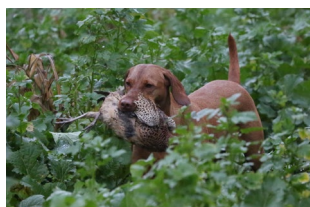
Withdrawals after the ballot will not be refunded.
